PUBLIC NOTICE

In public interest; it is hereby informed that all clients who send their food and water samples to the State Food Testing Laboratory, Meghalaya for analysis must submit a minimum of **three (3) identical samples** (i.e., in triplicate). This is necessary to ensure proper testing, verification, and record-keeping as per the standards and requirements of the laboratory.

Further, in cases where only **one sample** is submitted, the person or agency submitting the sample **must clearly indicate the nature of analysis required**—i.e., whether the sample is to be tested for **chemical parameters, microbiological parameters or HEE parameters**.

In the absence of such specification, the sample will by default be rejected.

All clients are requested to adhere strictly to these guidelines to avoid any delay or inconvenience in the testing process.
